The Nipmuck Scholarship Fund was established by the Nipmuck Tribal Council on November 26, 2011. The purpose of this award is to provide supplementary money to full and/or part time undergraduate/graduate students listed on the Tribal Roll of the Chaubunagungamaug Band of Nipmuck Indians. The funds are to be used for academic expenses including textbooks, lab fees, and/or tuition. The scholarship has a maximum value of \$1,000.00 annually and is based on fund availability. Scholarships may be awarded in lower increments dependent upon the number of applicants.
